Our barrels are available in two iconic formats: **Bordeaux Transport – 225 L** and **Burgundy – 228 L**. Each cask is offered with a choice of **22 mm or 27 mm stave thickness**.

Orion also offers a full range of **large-format casks**, crafted exclusively from **27 mm staves**. These formats ensure **low permeability and a slow, controlled oxygen exchange**, and are available in **300 L, 400 L, and 500 L** sizes.

For wineries seeking **extended ageing while preserving fruit freshness**, we also offer a **600 L model with 38 mm staves**, available upon request.

All large formats are available in both **fine grain** and **extra-fine grain**, depending on the desired wine profile, and can be tailored to any of our toasting programs.
